Join and celebrate with us Thursday, April 14, at 11 a.m. as we break ground on the expansion of the Shumaker Public Safety Center on HACC's Harrisburg Campus. The \$14.3 million expansion project will include construction of a new law enforcement center and critically needed improvements to the fire training grounds. The "Helping Tomorrow's First Responders, Today" campaign will provide financial support to this project. Approximately 30,000 first responders and emergency medical personnel a year receive their training at the facility. Lunch will be provided following a short program.
