State Rep. Kevin Schreiber, hosted a press conference at the campus along with Pennsylvania Education Secretary Pedro Rivera, HACC President John “Ski” Sygielski and President of the Pennsylvania Community College Commission, Elizabeth Bolden, to discuss community college funding in Pennsylvania and how Gov. Tom Wolf’s budget proposal can increase investment in community colleges. Specifically, the proposed budget would provide a \$15 million increase to community colleges, which would restore 75 percent of the cuts to community colleges since 2011. 


