prescription drugs, their uses, their brand names, their generic.

You learn compounding of IV fluids and, um, getting, uh,

the, TPN, the total parenteral mixes ready for the patients.

#### SAMEH SHAKER:

The most thing I like about pharmacy tech program is the compounding.

We also teach job readiness. Basically we teach them about the retail pharmacy, the mail-order pharmacies

Pharmacy technician roles here in WellSpan York Hospital vary. We have a lot of different roles
