Students who successfully pass the Piano Proficiency Exam at the end of the Fall Semester will fulfill the other keyboard credit with any music course. Students who do not pass (or attempt) the Piano Proficiency Exam in the fall will register for Keyboard II in the Courses for Messiah College have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and Messiah College. However, curricula are subject to change and it is in your best interest to speak with your advisor and/or the Messiah College transfer advisor if you have questions. Courses that are “recommended” fulfill HACC requirements, as well as Messiah College general education and/or major requirements. It is in your best interest to take the recommended courses.
