- 2. Criminal Justice courses must have a grade of “C” or better to transfer to Shippensburg..
- 3. The transfer counselor from Shippensburg University visits the Wildwood campus on a biweekly basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions or check the SU web site at www.ship.edu for the specific day and time.
