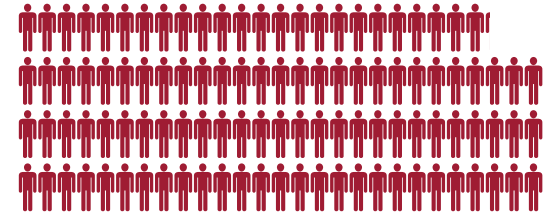
Impact of the increased earnings of HACC alumni and the businesses they work for

Construction spending impact

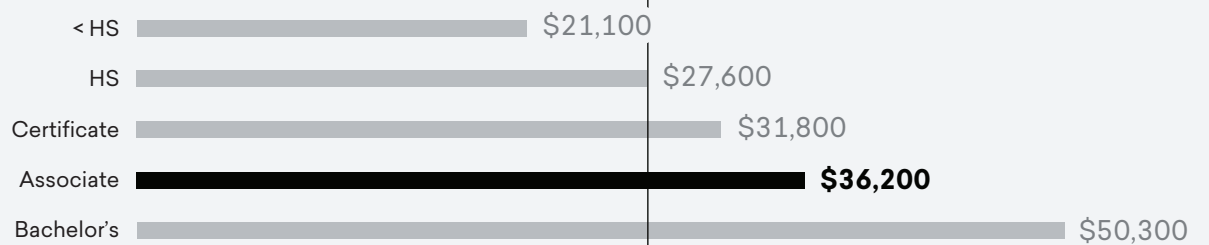

The average associate degree graduate from HACC will see an increase in earnings of **\$8,600** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Pennsylvania.



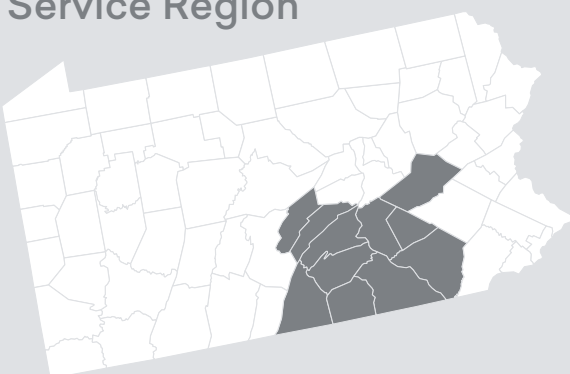
